We love Him because He first loved us.

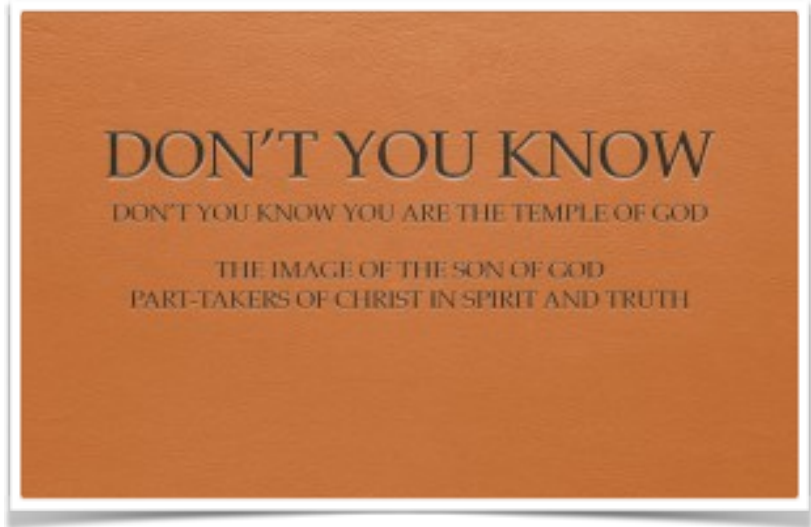

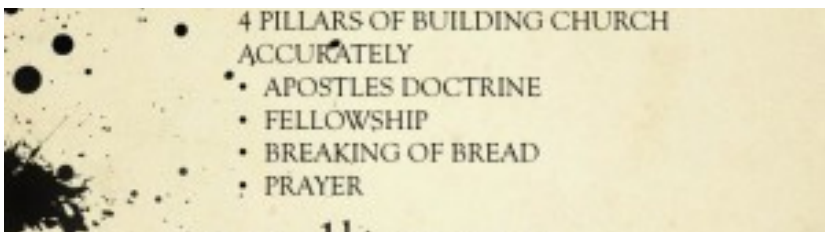

A MODEL FOR LEARNING

1. **Unconscious incompetence** / - Don't know what you know don't know
2. **Conscious incompetence** / - Know what you don't know
3. **Conscious competence** / - Know what you know
4. **Unconscious competence** / -What you know becomes part of you, you just are

If one apply this chart and its relevance to what is known about God one will most certainly reveal unconscious and conscious competence. The application of the model is informing our own levels of conscious and unconscious competence and incompetence. Most of our issues and struggles as believers are found in the area of conscious incompetence because what we don't know we don't know, and what we say we know and don't know is the problem. When it comes to pure doctrine we struggle with issues that we don't know instead of coming to the area of conscious competence with all humility and learning what is true and correct and having that become unconscious competence allow we know to become part of who we are.
